- Completed Application: Please fill out the top part of the application then take your application to your local Conservation Officer and have them fill in the bottom part of your application
- Copy of your WRC (Wildlife Resource Card) – front & back
- Copy of your PCOC (Pleasure Craft Operators Card) if you plan to fish from a boat or use a boat to transport clients
- Copy of your PAL (Possession and Acquisition License) if you are registering for the Hunting Guide Course
- Copy of you current First Aid/CPR Certificate if you have one, if you do not please note that you must have a current First Aid/CPR Certificate before you start guiding Please submit all of the above documents to kimvandevrie@gmail.com 902-897-7847
