- Fishing Guide Course only - \$400 – you would be required to attend Saturday and Sunday.
- Hunting Guide Course only - \$ 400 - you would be required to attend Sunday and Monday.
- Hunting and Fishing Guide Course only - \$ 500 - you would be required to attend Saturday, Sunday and Monday.
- Course times: Sat. 9am till 8pm, Sun. 8:30am till 8 pm, Mon. 8:30am till 3:30 pm.
- You will need a compass for these courses.



To register for the NS Guide Course please make sure you have the following (before submitting your application):

- Completed Application:** Please fill out the top part of the application then take your application to your local Conservation Officer and have them fill in the bottom part of your application
- Copy of your WRC (Wildlife Resource Card) – front & back**
- Copy of your PCOC (Pleasure Craft Operators Card) if you plan to fish from a boat or use a boat to transport clients**
- Copy of your PAL (Possession and Acquisition License) if you are registering for the Hunting Guide Course**
- Copy of your current First Aid/CPR Certificate if you have one, if you do not please note that you must have a current First Aid/CPR Certificate before you start guiding Please submit all of the above documents to [kimvandevrie@gmail.com](mailto:kimvandevrie@gmail.com) 902-897-7847**
